Finance Report

- After nine (9) months of activity (03/31), Lab has a positive Cash Balance (\$1.2M) and a Net Income (Deficit) of -\$1.3M.
- The school has begun to receive its Federal Grant revenues (\$295K payment in February, to be followed by a \$121K payment of Titled funding this month).

- The school meets the standard (Green) on 2/5 financial indicators tracked by the SD of Philadelphia but continues to trend negatively due to further enrollment decline (now 527)
- Lab will receive \$5.1M in Federal COVID-19 Relief (ARP ESSER) funding (to be used by Sep 2024), a significant portion of which (\$1.3M) will <u>supplant current year (2021-22) personnel costs</u>.
- Lab's 2022-23 Budget process is underway and will likely necessitate a scenario-based approach that may ultimately require right-sizing of staff in Summer 2022

In addition, a Draft FY23 Budget and separate Payroll List developed in collaboration with Dr. Coleman-Hill was reviewed. Key budget assumptions are as follows:

- Eliminated 6 legacy positions that will not be filled for next year.
- Added Tech Assistant at \$40K + Benefits
- Reduced expenses in Legal Services, Health/Nurse Services, Furniture, and Computers.
- Added 100 Students (50 Kindergarten + 5/grade level 1st-8th); 84 RegEd and 16 SpEd, bringing total enrollment to 668.
