## **Finance Report**

Enrollment has declined due to transportation issues. This has impacted revenue. The cash position remains strong. Direct receivables continue to arrive. Federal receivables such as ERRS-2 are owed. Accrued payroll expenses are continuing to grow. ESSR 3 will support payroll.

The balance sheet shows 1.4 million dollars cash on hand. There is a good system in place to monitor cash flow increases and deficits which will result in accurate day-to-day projections as cash flow changes.

Net income continues to be lower than expected due to enrollment issues caused by a lack of consistent transportation. Projected versus Actual budget is a concern due to the decline in income. Expenses are lower than projected.

#### **CEO Report**

The School District of Philadelphia is requesting a copy of the certificate you received from the ACT 55 Training. This is due to them by November 29, 2021. Two classrooms and attending staff were quarantined this month. LAB was notified on two different days that two unrelated students at the Sedgley Campus were sent to school by their parents while awaiting COVID test results. Both students were positive resulting in both classes and attending staff members being quarantined. As per the Board mandate, staff members are being released to receive vaccines. One employee will be released due to refusing to follow this mandate with no religious or medical exemption. One employee refused the vaccine and is now claiming a medical exemption. We are awaiting paperwork from the physician.

Support staff continues to be difficult to hire. Employees are hired and either do not show or work a few days and quit. LAB then receives unemployment paperwork.

Teaching staff is an issue at the Sedgley Ave. Campus. We are working to fill these vacancies.

One teacher at the Henry Ave. Campus is relocating for her spouse's job. That vacancy is posted.
